

## Amsterdam & Region Travel Ticket

The Amsterdam & Region Travel Ticket entitles you to unlimited travel in Amsterdam and its whole region -day and night- on bus, tram, metro and train.

The ticket is valid for 1, 2 or 3 calendar days from first check in. A day in this context begins at 0:00 AM and ends the next day at 4:00 AM.

With this ticket you always check in when boarding and check out when getting off the bus or tram. For metro or train you check in and out at the station (platform).

You can purchase your Amsterdam & Region Travel Ticket at various locations in and around Amsterdam.

## Amsterdam Beach & Haarlem

### Bus 80 (Connexxion): Amsterdam Beach Line

Route: Amsterdam Elandsgracht - Zandvoort Busstation

Bus 80, the Amsterdam Beach Line, takes you to the beautiful old city centre of Haarlem. Enjoy the beautiful

small streets and its picturesque houses. Or visit the Dutch first and oldest museum, open for public purposes since 1784; Teylers Museum. A visit to Teylers Museum is like a voyage through time, a voyage of discovery in the world of art and science.

## Old Holland: Zaanse Schans & Industrial Heritage

### Bus 391 (Connexxion): Industrial Heritage Line

A ride on bus 391, the Industrial Heritage Line, is well worth your time.

First stop: NDSM terrain. This former shipyard on the IJ river is bursting with creative activity. Second stop: Zaanadam Centre. The new renovated centre of Zaanadam is perfect for shopping and relaxing.

**Bus 891 (Connexxion):** Between 1 July and 31 August, 3 departures per hour between 10:00 AM and 3:00 PM directly from Central Station (river side) to Zaanse Schans in 20 minutes.

## Old Holland: Waterland & Smalltown Harbours

**Smalltown Harbours** Volendam, Edam, Marken, Hoorn and Monnickendam can be easily visited taking one of the frequent bus lines of EBS. Hop on and see how time stood still for several centuries. EBS buses depart from the river side of Amsterdam Central station.

**Bus 305 (EBS)** takes you (via Purmerend) to the Beemster. The Beemster reclaimed land is on the UNESCO's list of world heritage sites.

## Flowers of Amsterdam

### Bus 852 / 858 / 859 (only 21/3-19/05)

852: Europaplein (RAI) - Keukenhof / 858: Schiphol Airport - Keukenhof / 859: Hoofddorp station - Keukenhof

Discover Keukenhof. Come tip-toe through the tulips, admire the amaryllis and cruise past the crocuses at the Keukenhof Gardens, the world's largest flower gardens.

### Bus 357 (Connexxion)

Route: Amsterdam Elandsgracht - Aalsmeer Hortensiaplein

Discover Flower auction Flora Holland. The international trading platform for plants and flowers is a world in itself. You have to get up early to see this world-famous auction, but it is worth it!

## Amsterdam Airport Express

### Bus 397 (Connexxion)

Route: Schiphol Airport - Amsterdam Leidseplein / Elandsgracht

The Amsterdam Airport Express and NS trains provide a quick and easy transfer from Amsterdam Schiphol Airport to the city centre of Amsterdam.

Bus 397 leaves from bus platforms B17 in front of Schiphol Airport/Plaza.

## Amsterdam City

### Tram 2 and 11 (GVB)

Route: Central Station - Nieuw Sloten / Surinameplein

Trams 2 and 11 will take you right through the centre of Amsterdam to the bustling Leidseplein. At the tram stop Dam you can find the Royal Palace and National Monument. At the Leidseplein stop you will find cinemas, bars, restaurants and various theatres. Trams 2 and 11 depart in front of Central Station on the "B" side.

### Tram 14 (GVB)

Route: Central Station - Flevopark

Tram 14 will take you right through the centre of Amsterdam to the famous Rembrandtplein with cinemas, bars, restaurants and clubs. This line can also be used for the Hermitage Museum at tram stop Waterloooplein. Tram 14 also stops close to Artis Royal Zoo at stop Artis. Tram 14 departs in front of Central Station on the "A" side.

### Tram 2 and 12 (GVB)

Route: Central Station - Nieuw Sloten / Amstelstation

Trams 2 and 12 will take you right through the centre of Amsterdam to the Museum Quarter with Van Gogh museum, Rijksmuseum and Stedelijk museum. There are many hotels situated around Museumplein. Trams 2 and 5 depart in front of Central Station on the "B" side.

### Tram 13 and 17 (GVB)

Route: Central Station - Geuzenveld / Dijkgraafplein

Trams 13 and 17 will take you to the Jordaan, undoubtedly the most sung about, described and romanced town district in Amsterdam. Started as a district for the poor, today it is a favourite place for students, artists and young professionals. Close to tram stop Westermarkt you will find the Anne Frank House, where she wrote her world-famous diary while hiding in occupied Holland. Trams 13 and 17 depart in front of Central Station on the "B" side.
