

4 Spielzeugmuseum

Marienplatz 15

The Spielzeugmuseum is located in the tower of the Altes Rathaus directly on Marienplatz. With its rustic tower rooms, it is itself reminiscent of a doll house. It is pure nostalgia: dolls, soft toys, model railways and tin toys which go back more than 200 years are lovingly presented on more than four floors.

There is a cat! Where?

It is not that easy to spot it! It is sitting on the roof of the building between the Spielzeugmuseum and St.Peters-Kirche. As early as medieval Munich, figures of cats on the roof ridge were symbols of happiness and wealth and helped to prevent the building from being damaged.

5 Museum Villa Stuck

Prinzregentenstraße 60

Franz von Stuck's (1863 – 1928) villa was designed as a synthesis of the arts. Today its historical rooms accommodate a municipal museum. Traveling exhibitions of the 19th and 20th centuries as well as contemporary art are also on display.

Haidhausen City Quarter

The Haidhausen quarter with its historical village center, proximity to the Isar river, numerous quaint stores, boutiques and pubs ranks among the all-time favorites of Munich's 'in' neighborhoods.







7 Staatliches Museum Ägyptischer Kunst

Gabelsbergerstraße 35

The Ägyptische Museum focuses on the art of Old Egypt. The collection features famous exhibits and presents an overview of all epochs. Since summer 2013 the museum has been accommodated in a spectacular new building in the art quarter. www.smaek.de

Coffin mask

Time could not dull the sharpness and magic of her gaze: the coffin mask of Queen Satdjehutj from old Egypt (around 1650 BC).

8 NS-Dokumentationszentrum München

Brienner Staße 34

With the NS Documentation Center, opened in spring 2015, Munich has received a central place of learning and remembrance about the dark history of National Socialism. In addition to a permanent exhibition, the museum features a multimedia learning facility, special exhibitions as well as a diverse educational and event program.

DenkStätte Weiße Rose

Geschwister-Scholl-Platz 1

The DenkStätte Weiße Rose is located in the atrium of the Ludwig-Maximilians-Universität Munich, close to the historical place where the resistance fighters Hans and Sophie Scholl were arrested on February 18, 1943.







Königsplatz 1

The antique collections at Königsplatz (square) offer a vivid experience of the Greeks, Etruscans and Romans.

"Space Patrol"

The "deep-sea base 104", starting point of the "Orion" spacecraft from the German TV series "Space Patrol", was nothing else than the empty Königsplatz which at the time (1966) was still covered with large granite slabs.



Lerchenfeldstr. 2

The ASM is the central Bavarian state museum for pre-history and early history. It researches and presents finds from the pre-history of Bavaria to modern times- this is where archaeology comes to life. Its branch museums explain the history of human development in the respective region. (Re-opening 2023/24)

Hunting lodge of the Wittelsbach dynasty, prison, powder magazine- the Grünwald Castle boasts a varied and extremely exciting history. Today, the castle is a branch museum of the ASM and houses a permanent exhibition entitled "Castles in Bavaria"

The Deutsche Museum ranks among the greatest museums of technology and natural sciences in the world. In addition to historical originals it also presents models for experimenting. Natural laws, instruments and technical procedures are explained in a hands-on manner.

The world's first automobile

The world's first automobile Carl Benz patented the first petrol-driven car in 1886. The original three-wheeled vehicle is on display in the Deutsches Museum Verkehrszentrum (transport museum). The four-stroke engine had an output of 0.88 hp.



14 Bayerisches Nationalmuseum

Prinzregentenstraße 3

Works of European art and culture from the early Middle Ages to Art Nouveau, including sculptures, paintings and handicrafts. The manger collection featuring figurines from Naples, Sicily and the alpine region is world-famous.

17 Residenzmuseum

Residenzstraße 1

The Residenz, one of the greatest palaces in Germany, served as residence and seat of government to the Wittelsbach rulers until 1918. The splendid historical rooms and the Treasure Chamber are as impressive as the art collections.

18 Bier- und Oktoberfestmuseum

Sterneckerstraße 2

The history of Munich breweries and beer production is displayed in Munich's oldest town house which dates back to 1340. The museum tour explains the development of the Munich Oktoberfest from the royal wedding in 1810 to the greatest folk festival in the world.

21 Münchner Stadtmuseum

St -Jakobs-Platz 1

'Typically Munich!' is the title of the great display about the history of the city. Additional highlights of the multi-facetted collections, that also comprise the film museum, include photography, contemporary events, musical instruments and puppet theater / fairground attractions.











Schloß Nymphenburg 1

The former summer residence of the Wittelsbach dynasty is a feast for the eyes among the baroque palace complexes of Europe. The highlights of the palace are the impressive Stone Hall with its fresco cycle and King Ludwig I's famous Schönheitengalerie (Gallery of Beauty).

The Park Castles

In the extensive Schloss Nymphenburg (Nymphenburg Palace) park, a hunting lodge, a baroque bath, a pagoda and a hermitage have been preserved in their original form. All were built in the first half of the 18th century.



Sterneckerstraße 2

The spacious complex with the New Palace, Old Palace and Lustheim Palace is an impressive testimony to court architecture and Baroque garden art of the 17th and 18th centuries.

Flugwerft Schleißheim

The exhibition features pieces documenting the history of civil and military aviation from the first aircraft in 1907 to the Eurofighter.
