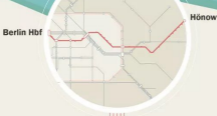


## U5 – sightseeing by metro

Rotes Rathaus

Elegant in black and white – an architecture inspired by the medieval town hall's historic ceiling vault.



Museumsinsel

Under a starry sky – the ceiling references Prussian architect Friedrich Schinkel and his stage setting for Mozart's Magic Flute. (Station to open mid-2021)



Unter den Linden

The 'science station' – the wall design explores the Anthropocene age, the current geological period with human activity shaping the Earth.
